New Salem Hosts 6th Annual Hilltown Brewfest Fire Department Fundraiser Saturday, Sept. 7

The New Salem General Store to present tasting of 30+ brands, covering a wide variety of styles of craft beers, wines, cider, and mead; net proceeds will be donated to local fire departments.

This 6th annual afternoon tasting will feature more than 30 mostly regional brands, offering many styles of beer along with select offerings of wine, cider and mead. In addition to the brews, there will be local foods, raffles and live music. As has been done every year, the net proceeds of the Brewfest will be donated to the local Fire Departments to augment their budgets. "Last year's Hilltown Brewfest in New Salem was a great success, with upwards of 800 people attending", explained Rick Oliver, proprietor of the New Salem General Store. "The Hilltown Brewfest recognizes and promotes our area's outstanding brewers and provides a fun venue for craft brew enthusiasts to sample a wide and tasty variety of mostly local or regionally produced beverages."

The Cigar Bar will return this year and the New Salem and Wendell Fire Departments will again hold a 50/50 raffle, which paid out over \$600 in prizes last year.

Tickets are \$25.00 the day of the Brewfest at the gate and there is ample free parking. Attendees who volunteer to be designated drivers will receive a discounted event price of \$10.00 at the door.
